Prayer Shawl Ministry

Pocket Prayer Shawl with Cross Motif Pattern

(60 minutes to completion...Approximately)

This is an original pattern created by one of the members of our Prayer Shawl Ministry.

Purpose: The purpose of the **Pocket Prayer Shawl** is to provide feelings of comfort, support, and closeness to God for the recipient. They fit nicely in a pocket or purse, and can travel with the recipient.

Usually, one is made with a tassel at the end.

Two could be made and put together to form a pouch. The pouch could hold anything that is meaningful and comforting to the recipient.

Supplies: A few ounces of 4 ply worsted yarn. (3 ply or baby yarn with 2 strands together.) Soft yarns like *Caron Simply Soft* or *Red Heart Soft* are comforting to touch. Avoid coarse feeling yarns. Variegated yarns will not show the motif as well as solid colors. Choose comforting colors such as green, blue, white, tan, brown, purple, soft gold, and pastels. Avoid bright colors and neon colors. Also, *Lion Brand Homespun* does not work as it Is too bulky.

Use needle sizes 4, 5, 6, 7 or 8 depending on what size you wish the outcome to be, and how loosely or tightly you knit. Use whatever size needles will give you the finished dimensions of about 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches by 3 inches. You have the option of making it smaller or larger than the stated size. Experiment with yarn and the size to find what you like.

Use a **crochet hook** for attaching the tassel.

Preparing the knitter... Find a quiet place to knit that will be your time of prayer. As you work, pray for the recipient's healing and comfort.

Directions for construction:

Cast on 18 stitches Rows 1 through 5 Knit (Garter Stitch) Row 6 Knit 8, Purl 2, Knit 8 Row 7 Knit Rows 8, 10, 12 Knit 8, Purl 2, Knit 8 Rows 9, 11, 13 Knit Row 14 Knit 5, Purl 8, Knit 5 Row 15 Knit Row 16 Knit8, Purl 2, Knit 8 Row 17 Knit Rows 18 and 20 Knit 8, Purl 2, Knit 8 Rows 19 and 21 Knit Rows 22 through 26 Knit Bind Off

Cut 3 strands of yarn, each 12 inches long. Fold In half making a loop. Put a crochet hook into the center of the 3 ½ inch side. Pick up the loop and pull the tail of the tassel through the loop to secure the tassel to the **Pocket Prayer Shawl**. This forms a 6 strand tassel.

Embellishment

Optional: You may thread letter beads onto one or more of the strands of the tassel to spell a comforting word such as "love, heal, peace, hope, trust, faith, praise, pray, or other meaningful word." Put a knot or two at the end to secure the beads in place.

Blessing...

Our Prayer Shawl Ministry has a monthly blessing of **Pocket Prayer Shawls** and our full size **Prayer Shawls**. They are placed on the altar rail and members of the congregation come to the rail for a laying on of hands blessing. Then the Shawls are ready to go to those in need of the comfort they provide.

Tagging...

We attach a business size tag (*see below*), showing a picture of "hands holding", to each **Pocket Prayer Shawl** that says the following:

"As you hold your Pocket Prayer Shawl, you hold the Hand of God. May you feel His loving and comforting touch. The cross in the middle connects you to Jesus and His blessings. Know that He is always with you."

Distribution...


